

LEGAL NOTICE

What is this Case About?

On May 14, 2003, Plaintiff Gloria Huey filed a Complaint against Dana's Housekeeping Personnel Service. The settlement is based upon Plaintiffs contentions that Defendant violated certain provisions of California Civil Code §1812.5095 for Employment Agencies, and failed to provide Housekeepers with employee rights, including overtime, and wage statements. Specifically, the lawsuit alleges that Dana's Housekeeping at times referred to Housekeepers as "Independent Contractors", did not allow them to negotiate with Clientele, terminated housekeeper/clientele relationships, and did not maintain a Surety Bond. Defendant Dana's Housekeeping denies any wrongdoing, and asserts that they properly followed all laws relating to Employment Agencies, and properly compensated the Housekeepers. The Court did not decide who was right. But both sides agreed to a dismissal from this action of the employee rights claims, including the claims for unpaid overtime compensation and that housekeepers failed to received proper written itemized statements of hours worked, wages and deductions. Both sides also agreed to a settlement of the Civil Code violation claims relating to references to Housekeepers as Independent Contractors to resolve the case.

Who is Included?

You are a class member, and could get benefits if you were registered as a Housekeeper with Dana's Housekeeping between September 1, 2001 and April 25, 2004. After April 25, 2004 Dana's Housekeeping policies were changed and the plaintiff does not allege any subsequent violations of the law. What does the Settlement Provide?

Dana's Housekeeping has agreed to provide a total settlement fund of \$60,000 to be divided among all Class Members who send in valid claim forms. All settlement awards are subject to tax. After deduction of attorney's fees (\$19,800), costs (\$2466.35), claims administration(\$9,000) and service payment (\$6,000), the Net Settlement Fund of \$22,733.64 will be divided evenly among the class members based on the number of claims submitted. Regardless of the number of claims made, Dana's Housekeeping will pay the entire settlement fund of \$60,000.

Your Legal Rights and Options

Your Legal Rights are affected by whether you do or don't act. Read this notice carefully.

Submit a Claim Form.	The only way to get a payment is to submit a claim form by June 1, 2009. Claim Forms are available at www.emiliolaw.com/danashousekeeping , or can be requested by calling the Claims Administrator at 888-379-4LAW. All Late Forms will be Rejected.
Exclude Yourself from the Settlement	If you do not wish to participate in this settlement, you may send an exclusion request with your Names, Address, and Social Security Number, and Your Desire to be Excluded from the Settlement. Your Request must be sent by Certified Mail to the Claims Administrator Below before June 1, 2009.
Object to the Settlement	You can Object to the Settlement before Final Approval, by filing a written objection and notice of intention to appear at the Final Approval Hearing set for July 14, 2009. This Objections must be filed by June 1, 2009
Do Nothing	If you choose to do nothing, you will not receive any payment, and you will be giving up your rights in this claim.

The Court will hold a hearing in Dept. 24 of the Los Angeles Superior Court, 111 North Hill Street, Los Angeles, California 90012 on July 14, 2009 at 8:30am, to determine whether the Settlement should be finally approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate. The Court also will be asked to approve Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and costs and the service payment to be paid to the Class Representative. The hearing may be continued without further notice to the Settlement Class. ***It is not necessary for you to appear at this hearing. Please Do NOT telephone the Court or Court Clerk for information regarding this settlement or the claim process!***

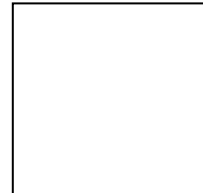
**If You were registered as a housekeeper with Dana's Housekeeping
between September 1, 2001 and April 25, 2004,
a Class Action Lawsuit may affect your rights.**

Our Records indicate that you may be affected by a lawsuit alleging that Dana's Houskeeping violated California Civil Code §1812.5095 for Employment Agencies. The Case is called Huey v. Danas Housekeeping , No. BC295680, and is in the Los Angeles Superior Court, Central Court. A Settlement has been proposed in this lawsuit that will provide a total settlement fund of \$60,000 to qualified Housekeepers. If you qualify, you may send in a claim form to obtain benefits, or you may exclude yourself from the settlement, or object to it. The Los Angeles Superior Court authorized this notice. Before any money is paid, the Court will have a hearing to decide whether to approve the settlement.
